

Banking on It

To Prepare:

Laminate 2 copies of the game cards, cut them out and glue them on craft sticks.

Put the sticks in an opaque bag or container.

Laminate the answer key.



To Play:

- A small group of students sit together.
- One player removes a random stick from the bag and counts the coins to determine the value.
- If the student is correct, s/he keeps the stick. Another player can use the key to check the answer.
- If the student is incorrect, the stick goes back in the bag.
- If the player gets a “BANK” stick, he puts it aside and takes one stick from each player to keep in his or her own pile.
- Players take turns until time is up or there are no sticks left in the bag.
- The player with the most sticks wins. If there is a tie, the player with the stick that has the greatest money value wins!
