## Place Value Challenge

- Deck of cards
- One chip with GREATER written on one side, LOWER on the other or a spinner with the same labels
- Scrap paper


## To play:

Deal out the entire deck so that each player has an equal amount of cards.

Each player turns over 2 cards and makes the best number possible with the three cards.

One player then "flips" the counter, like a coin, to see who wins... the person with the higher number or the lower number. (or uses the spinner)

Players keep track of the two numbers and who won on each round. After ten rounds (or a number the teacher designates), the player with more wins is the Challenge Champ.
